Contact Lens Information and Pricing Policies:

Do you currently wear contact lenses? YES NO If yes, what brand?

We will fit you with the healthiest contact lenses for your lifestyle. Not all contact lenses are available from alternative distributors (internet, drugstores, etc.).

I understand that evaluation/exam and fitting fees are NON-REFUNDABLE and are based upon complexity:

- \$50 Annual evaluation fee to renew contact lens prescription *without brand changes*
- \$75 Soft disposable/Extended wear lenses
- \$90 Soft Toric (astigmatism)/Mono-vision/Rigid Gas Permeable (RGP non-toric)
- \$150 Rigid Gas Permeable (RGP Toric)/Bifocal(Multifocal)/Custom contacts/ Kerataconus/
Soft Toric Bifocal

All follow up appointments must be kept in order to obtain a copy of my contact lens prescription.

Notice of Refraction Fees for Glasses Rx

A refraction is the test that is performed to determine your eyeglass prescription. A refraction may be performed by either the doctor or a technician, and typically involves questioning along the lines of, "Is 1 better than 2?"

Medicare and many other insurance plans consider a refraction to be routine vision care NOT covered under their medical coverage, so this amount is charged separately and the patients' responsibility. Medicare secondary insurance plans will also not pay the charge since it is not a Medicare-covered service, so the \$35.00 fee is to be paid by the patient.

In order to keep the refraction current, the policy is to perform a refraction at least every two (2) years or if there is a change in vision.
